

RESOLUTION NO. 3126

A RESOLUTION of the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle authorizing application for, and acceptance of, funding assistance for repairs of certain Port facilities from the Federal Emergency Management Agency 896 Hazard Mitigation Grant Program and designation of the Director, Risk Management and Loss Prevention, as agent for the Port with respect to such program.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Federal Disaster Relief and Emergency Act, 42 U.S.C. Section 5121, et seq., and the Federal Emergency Management Agency 896 Hazard Mitigation Grant Program, certain federal and state funds have been made available to assist municipalities in funding repairs caused by severe storm damage; and

WHEREAS, Pier 17 sustained severe damage during the winter storms of 1990; and

WHEREAS, these program funds are available upon application by the Port to the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) through the State of Washington Department of Community Development;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Commission of the Port of Seattle as follows:

Section 1. That the Director, Risk Management and Loss Prevention, be designated as agent for the Port for purposes of working with, applying for, and accepting funds from FEMA.

Section 2. That this resolution become part of a formal application to FEMA.

ADOPTED by the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle at its regular meeting held this 22nd day of September, 1992 and duly authenticated in open session with the signatures of the Commissioners voting in favor thereof and the seal of the Commission duly affixed.
